"Female high school students who have completed their junior year are competitively selected and sponsored by American Legion Auxiliary units for this program, where they learn about the political process by electing officials for all levels of state government and actively running a mock government. The girls are assigned to mock cities and either the "Federalist Party", or the "Nationalist Party".

"Assistance from dedicated ALA volunteers ensures the programs nonpartisan governmental, patriotic, and civic objectives are carried out through interactive learning. Candidates should be keenly interested in government and current events, and show strong leadership abilities".

The ALA has sponsored Girls State since its inception in 1947.

Unit 62 will be sponsoring 14 schools this year with Canyon View in Waddell as a new addition.

Our Cost will be budgeted at \$6,900. This could increase if Girls are unable to pay their \$100 portion.
